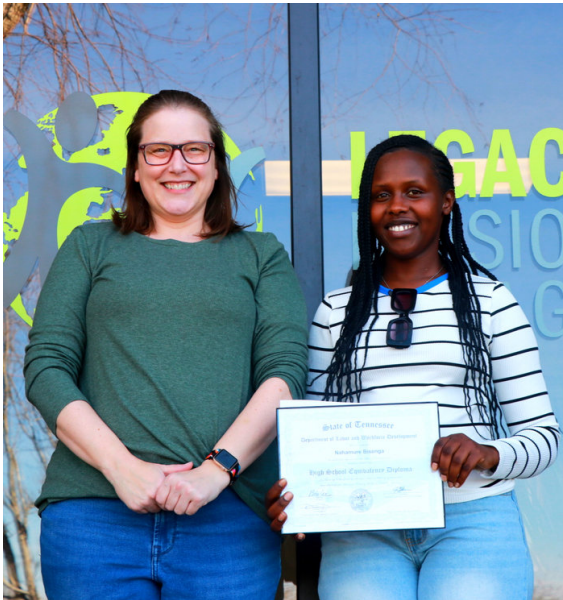

The NPL Puppet Truck Visits KRP



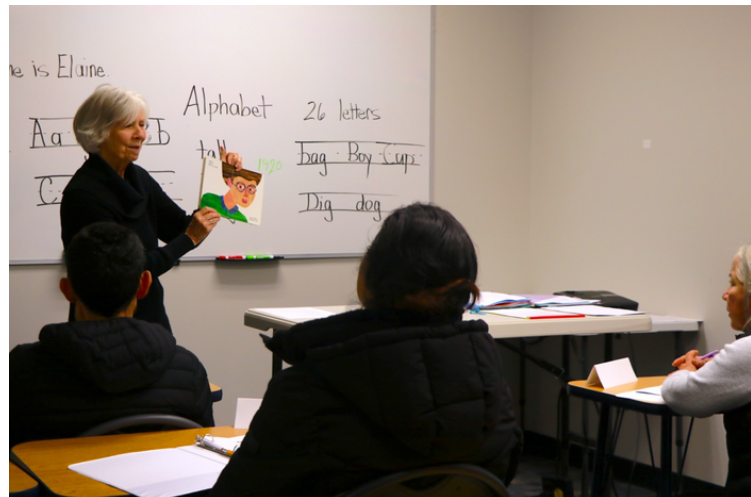
Do you know what a marionette is? Our KRP students do! This month the Nashville Library's puppet truck came to delight our little ones with a performance of *The Little Rabbit that*
